Protocol

- * New chairmen were elected. Oskar Angenete and Annja Viset, both from St Olav's University Hospital in Trondheim, will split the chairmanship.
- * Educative cases from participants of the Imaging Group were presented and discussed, especially sclerotic lesions such as osteoblastoma, osteosarcomas, but also unusual presentation of GCT, fibrous dysplasia and lymphoma.
- * Future possible methods were discussed:
 - * Real-time fusion of ultrasound and MRI/CT for bone or soft-tissue biopsies.
 - * ¹⁸F-Sodium Fluoride PET for improved detection of sclerotic bone metastases.
 - * PET/MRI instead of PET/CT to lessen radiation dose in follow-up of children.
- * Timelines for the "Standardiserat vårdförlopp för Skelett-och mjukdelssarkom" in Sweden was discussed.
