- **Histopathological review**
 - SSGXX: The protocol is now closed .17 cases were reviewed. One case was included again because the needle biopsy could be reviewed (Case nr 2417).
 - Euroboss: 6 cases reviewed.
 - MPNST: 12 cases
 - Other cases: About 12 difficult or interesting cases were discussed.
 - A total of 32 cases from review were finished.
 - **The next review meeting** is planned to 5.-6. March 2015 in Trondheim, Norway.
 - Program
 - Cases included in SSGXX, the goal is to finish the review of included patients in this protocol
 - Cases included in Euroboss
 - MPNST, few cases
 - Difficult and interesting cases
 - Retroperitoneal sarcomas, particularly liposarcoma
 - Vascular tumors in bone. Magnus Hanson will start a research project on vascular tumors in bone including angiosarcomas, epithelioid hemangioendothelioma and epithelioid hemangioma. We will first try to get an overview over how many cases there are in the SSG Registry.
 - Planning of **course in soft tissue tumors** in 2016. Norway takes the responsibility for this.
