-Discussion on the practicalities of multidisciplinary meetings (MDM) in other areas than sarcoma. Interesting experiences from Umeå where technical solutions have made national conferences possible. How will this work out when the national program for sarcoma is implemented? Further discussions on this topic the coming years.

-Preparations for MDM is time consuming and this is hard to adequately communicate to head of departments and economists. How to measure workload?

-Update on imaging and biopsy rationale on chondromatous tumours. Presentation by Annja Viset and a fruitful discussion afterwards.

-We had an informal survey on the different practices for ultrasound examinations of suspected soft tissue tumors. There are big differences in the workflow for biopsies/cytologic sampling between our centers.

-We will begin the process of updating the recommendations for the MRI-protocol for sarcoma imaging. The new, recommended protocol will be discussed during 2019.

-In the next working group meeting Conny Ström will give us an update on diffusion weighted imaging in sarcoma.
