Discussions were held regarding

- Adipose tissue tumors
  - How to image?
  - When to image?
  - When to do ultrasound and who should do it?

Topic for next year WGM will be bone tumors; benign and malignant both from a radiologic and nuclear medicine perspective

Next year the group will invite experts on AI in imaging who hopefully we will give a lecture on where AI in imaging stands today .

We shared experiences in bone biopsy techniques.

Challenging cases were discussed, both from a work-flow point of view and regarding diagnostic challenges.

There is a wish to establish an international platform for sharing imaging both for educational purposes and for help with differential diagnostics. However, the legal issue concerning image distribution does not seem to be completely solved.
