Preface

We wish all participants, external guests, and lecturers welcome to the Scandinavian Sarcoma Group 41st plenary meeting in Gothenburg, Sweden, May 22-24, 2024! We are very happy to announce the participation of several excellent invited speakers both from the Nordic countries and abroad.

The meeting will begin on Wednesday morning, May 22, with a joint session with all participants focused on spinal and pelvic tumors. This first session will cover surgery, reconstruction, and instructive cases. The second session will have a special emphasis on radiotherapy. Hillevi Rylander, Head of the Skandion Clinic in Stockholm, will talk about Proton Beam therapy for sarcoma patients and Reiko Imai, from Japan, will talk about Carbon therapy. We hope that these lectures will be exciting and highlight new ways to treat sarcomas with radiotherapy.

Dario Callegaro from Milan, Italy, will then present a new study: Neoadjuvant treatment in high-risk STS of the extremities and superficial trunk.

The afternoon session will also be covering very important subjects where Florian Puls, pathologist at Gothenburg University Hospital, will talk about ALK-driven tumors, Felix Haglund de Flon, pathologist at Karolinska University Hospital in Stockholm will talk about Whole Genome Sequencing and Nischalan Pillay, London, will talk about Pathology in sarcomas. The last speaker of the day, Claudia Valverde, GEIS, Spain, will talk about Immunotherapy in STS.

On Thursday, May 23, we will concentrate on Bone sarcomas and Emanuela Palmerini from Bologna will talk about Pelvic bone tumors. Furthermore, ongoing trials for sarcoma in children, Radiology and Biopsies as well as Desmoid tumors will be discussed. Winnette Van der Graaf and Pjotr Rutkowski will talk about Medical treatment and Surgical treatment of desmoids. The last session of the day will focus on Circulation cell free DNA and finally Sylvie Bonvalot will talk about Surgical treatment in complex cases. The nurses- and physiotherapy program will focus on innovation, nurse consulting and rehabilitation when Quality of Life is the goal!

On Friday, May 24, researchers will present their ongoing and inspiring research projects. We will then have a special guest from Ukraine, Oleg Vyrva, who will talk about Oncoorthopedics at War in Ukraine. Furthermore, the nurses and physiotherapists will discuss how to treat adolescents and young adults at home. This last day will close with an interactive session with presentation of multidisciplinary cases.

We wish you an enjoyable and memorable stay in Gothenburg!
