

Minutes of SSG Board Meeting 22.3.2024 Teams 14.00-14.35

1. Eva-Mari Olofsson will work for SSG only 20 % from 1.5., there are economic reasons behind this decision. The rest of her working time will be spent in other projects, at least for a year. 4. Trial: Pereli-trial by Kjetil Boye will start in May 2024.
In the rEECur study (an International Randomized Controlled Trial of Chemotherapy for the Treatment of Recurrent and Primary Refractory Ewing Sarcoma) an experimental arm with Lenvatinib treatment will be open. The participating Scandinavian country are Finland, Norway and Denmark. Sweden has not yet entered the study.
